

# Survey of Likely General Election Voters Statewide in Oregon

*Topline Report – August 1, 2018*

Clout Research conducted a telephone survey of likely General Election voters statewide in Oregon. The survey was conducted July 30-31, 2018. The survey included 559 interviews with voters in both landline households and households with only mobile phones. It carries a confidence interval of 95% and a margin of error of +/- 4.14 percentage points.

Q2: Generally speaking, would you say things here in Oregon are headed in the right direction, or would you say they are off on the wrong track?
