

Survey of Likely General Election Voters in Oregon

Topline Report – Sept. 26, 2022

Clout Research conducted a telephone survey of likely General Election voters in Oregon regarding the upcoming November election. The survey included 422 respondents in both landline and mobile phone households. It was conducted September 23-26, 2022. The poll carries a confidence interval of 95% and a margin of error of +/- 4.77 percentage points.
