

# Survey of Likely General Election Voters in Oregon CD5

*Topline Report – Aug. 18, 2022*

Clout Research conducted a telephone survey of 410 likely General Election voters in Oregon’s Fifth Congressional District regarding the upcoming November election. The survey was conducted using interviews with both landline and mobile phone respondents. The survey was conducted August 15-18, 2022 and carries a confidence interval of 95% and a margin of error of +/- 4.84 percentage points.
